Basic function: Provide psychotherapy, part-time at 20 hrs/week or fee for service, with primary population focus on children, teens and families.

Primary Job Responsibilities include:

- Provide psychotherapy to clients of all faiths in a warm and welcoming environment.
- Conduct functional and strength-based assessment along with comprehensive diagnosis for mental health, substance abuse, trauma, and psychosocial needs; Evaluate each client's mental condition based on review of client information, interviews, observation, tests, and collaboration with other providers.
- Develop and implement initial treatment plan at first session.
- Responsible for timely completion of paperwork, including written psychosocial assessments and formal treatment plans within two weeks of initial session and progress notes completed within one business day after session.
- Provide phone and/or Video Therapy as needed by a HIPPA approved platform only. (i.e., Doxy.me).
- Modify treatment activities and approaches as needed to comply with changes in clients' status.
- Make appropriate referrals to alternative community resources as indicated.
- Clinical supervision provided by Clinical Supervisor.
